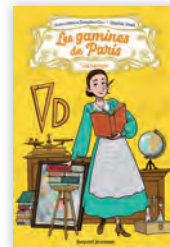

A new book in the '100 Episodes' series, marking the reopening of Notre-Dame. From its beginnings as a Celtic temple to the fire that ravaged the cathedral, Evelyne Brisou-Pellen looks back over 2,000 years of history.

It all began in 62 BC, when the Druids built a new temple in the heart of the city of Lutetia, using an oak tree to support the doorway. The tree-turned-pillar has witnessed many major historical events: when the city was conquered by the Romans, Viking invasions, royal coronations, revolutions... The temple became a Roman fanum, then a church, and, finally, the cathedral as we know it today. The tree also tells the story of a family that, from generation to

generation, has always had close ties with this Parisian monument.

Evelyne's experienced writing (3 million copies sold) embarks readers on a journey through the centuries from an original viewpoint: that of a tree used to build the very first temple. Djilian Deroche's illustrations embellish the text by plunging readers into precise, well-documented images with strong symbolic meaning. ■
