Quetzalcoatlus

- Period: Late Cretaceous (70 million to 66 million years ago)
- Region: North America
- Maximum size: 39-foot (12-meter) wingspan
- Maximum weight: 440 pounds (200 kilograms)

The Quetzalcoatlus was not a dinosaur, but a type of flying reptile known as a pterosaur. While it was large, it had hollow bones and a small body, which made it light enough to fly. The Quetzalcoatlus had a rigid neck that measured nearly 10 feet (3 meters) in length and a long, toothless jaw. Scientists believe it swooped down to catch fish from the water and walked on the ground to snap up small dinosaurs.
