


## ILLUSTRATOR

Mary-Stone can count on her parents and her best friend to help her through all these stages... Or experiencing her first confinement.

All these funny and tender confidences, drawn in biros, give the impression of delving into the diaries of today's teenagers.

A comic that will appeal to young adults who will look back with a nostalgic smile, to teenagers who will find support in it, and to their parents who will better understand their child who has grown up so much. The book is a revival of a series published in *Phosphore* (380,000 readers/month).

She published a bestselling trilogy about pregnancy and motherhood (*La Naissance en BD*, nearly 62,000 copies sold). 





## KEY WORDS : SCULPTOR, ART, 20TH CENTURY

Rediscover the sculptor Germaine Richier, a pioneering artist, major figure in modern art and Bourdelle's final apprentice, whose work is particularly relevant today (hybridity, fusion of man and nature). This book, illustrated by Olivia Sautreuil (*Le feuilleton d'Artémis*), accompanies the Germaine Richier retrospective exhibition at Beaubourg, in partnership with the Centre Pompidou in Paris, and traces the artist's bright career path and powerful imagination throughout the 20th century.



## AUTHOR



**Laurence Durieu**, Germaine Richier's great niece, is a journalist who has been working on archives, interviews and texts about the artist since 2007. She has partnered with major national and international museums to promote Richier's work. A retrospective exhibition will be held at the Centre Pompidou in Paris in March 2023, before moving to the Musée Fabre in Montpellier over the summer.

## ILLUSTRATOR



**Olivia Sautreuil** is a graphic designer and illustrator for the press and publishing (Milan, Gallimard Jeunesse, etc.). She has illustrated several books published by Bayard, including *Artemis* from the "Feuilletons de la Mythologie" series, a non-fiction novel about Thor, or *Bestioles*, a picture book for little ones.

**Rebecca Manzoni** is a journalist, music critic and radio producer. She regularly works for Arte and is mainly known as a radio host on France Inter. She presents *Tubes & Co* and *Pop'n'Co* every week, where she talks about music in all its forms with a great deal of humor and panache.

## ILLUSTRATOR



**Émilie Valentin** is an independent journalist, screenwriter and author. She produced the documentary "Sculptrices, ni muses, ni modèles" for Arte and adapted Pénélope Bagieu's comic book, *Culottées*, into an animated series for France Télévisions.


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# Lebensborn

One morning, while walking with her baby son, Isabelle Maroger is approached by a woman who compliments her on her beautiful blond-haired, blue-eyed child and adds, «It's becoming a rare breed»...

A shock for Isabelle, who realizes that it's time for her to tell her story. The reason she, too, is tall, blond and blue-eyed is because she's half-Norwegian. During the war, her mother was born in a Lebensborn, the maternity wards set up by the Nazis to mass-produce little Aryans.

Isabelle will recount the investigation that enabled her mother, and therefore the whole family, to discover the secret of her birth, and all the consequences that this will entail, the intimate upheavals, the questioning, the changing relationships between children and parents.



## AUTHOR-ILLUSTRATOR



Born in Montpellier in 1979 to a French father and Norwegian mother, **Isabelle Maroger** lives in Lyon. She spent her childhood doodling, began art studies and eventually entered the Émile Cohl school in Lyon. She illustrates children's books and women's magazines, creating graphic images that make you smile. For Bayard, she illustrated the *Lola* and *Fanny au poney-club* series.



## KEY WORDS : TELEPHONE, JAPAN, TECHNOLOGY


Every day, millions of emojis are shared around the world. A young journalist realizes that her phone has a gas pump emoji, a nuclear power plant emoji and an oil barrel emoji, but no windmill emoji. She starts investigating: who decides which emojis accompany us in our daily lives? She meets the Japanese creator of the first emojis, the American intern who drew the most popular icons, a lawyer specializing in emoji (can you go to prison if you send a pistol emoji?), an Egyptologist who compares hieroglyphics and emojis... And retraces the global history of a phenomenon. The first comic-book investigation into emojis, their history and trade secrets shows a pop, light-hearted universe, revealing some very topical questions: are images really universal? Can GAFAM alone decide how we exchange?

## AUTHOR



**David Groison** directed Bayard's teen press for ten years, and produced several books on the decoding of images and photos for Actes Sud Jeunesse.

## ILLUSTRATOR



**Paul Rey** studied at the Beaux-Arts in Angoulême. He has published two graphic novels with Sarbacane, including *Syndrôme de l'iceberg*, which explores the place of the virtual and artificial intelligence in our lives.
